IMPACT OF TRAVELERS IN WISCONSIN'S NORTHWOODS



Wisconsin's Northwoods includes the counties of Ashland, Barron, Bayfield, Burnett, Clark, Florence, Forest, Iron, Langlade, Lincoln, Oneida, Pierce, Polk, Price, Rusk, St. Croix, Sanyer, Taylor, Vilas and Washburn.

All Travelers

Eighty-five percent of the visitors in the Wisconsin's Northwoods were on a leisure trip, 13% were on individual business trips, and 2% were attending meetings or conventions. All travelers spent \$1.5 billion in this region in 2002.

- Summer travelers spent \$796 million
- Winter/spring travelers spent \$360 million
- Fall travelers spent \$364 million

Leisure Travelers

In 2002, leisure travelers spent \$1.3 billion in Wisconsin's Northwoods.

- Summer leisure travelers spent \$698 million
- Winter/spring leisure travelers spent \$288 million
- Fall leisure travelers spent \$297 million
