Additional information (at the above link) and questions staff and leaders often ask:

- 1. Leaders need to consult 4-H staff in their county prior to registering for a certification workshop.
- 2. Must be at least age 21 to attend a certification workshop.
- 3. Be an approved leader in the county or working with 4-H staff on acquiring leader status at the time of registration.
- 4. Volunteers must complete the National 4-H Shooting Sports online training prior to attending a certification workshop required only when attending first certification. (This is a one-time training having a \$20 credit card fee.)
- 5. Credit card is the preferred payment method.
- 6. Certification workshop fees are \$65 each and \$65/\$35 when both spouses attend the same discipline at the same certification workshop. Each will need to complete separate registration forms and make separate payments, one for \$65 one for \$35.
- 7. If a county reimburses leader fees, the completion certificate emailed to leaders is proof of the \$65 payment. Doug can provide a receipt if requested. The certificate leaders are emailed immediately upon completing the National training is the only receipt for the \$20 payment. Attendance at the complete 8-hour Saturday certification is required.




