3RD GRADE AND UP



PAPER QUILLING

Grades 3 and up



Quilling is a beautiful art form that lets you create intricate designs by simply rolling and shaping paper. The session will provide the main materials you'll need to get started: a quilling tool (used for rolling the paper strips), the paper strips themselves, and cardstock for your base design. The most important thing to remember is to bring your own glue. Any liquid craft glue that dries clear will work perfectly. A bottle with a fine tip is helpful for precise application, but you can also use a toothpick to apply small dots of glue.
