



Burnett County 4-H

Project Grants provide financial support to help members achieve their 4-H goals in specific project areas.

- **Deadline:** All grant applications are due by **September 15, 2025, at 7pm.** (or at the September Adult Leaders meeting when Record Books are due)
- **How to Apply:** Complete the Google Form for each grant you wish to apply for. Click or Scan: <https://forms.gle/TEzJwgfu87XKUVpd6>
- **Important:** You may apply for multiple grants, but each member can only be awarded **one grant** per year. Once a grant is received, you are ineligible to apply for it again in the future.
- **Available Grants (Each is \$25):**
 - **NANCY CARLSON MEMORIAL GRANT**
 - **Eligibility:** 4-H members aged 9-10 years old (must be their first time receiving this grant).
 - **Purpose:** Can be used in any 4-H project area.
 - **CLAIRE ERICKSON MEMORIAL GRANT**
 - **Eligibility:** 4-H horse or horseless project members (must be their first time receiving this grant).
 - **Purpose:** For horse project-related activities.
 - **BESSIE PETERSON MEMORIAL GRANT**
 - **Eligibility:** 4-H members aged 11-14 years old who have demonstrated achievement in the past two years of project work.
 - **Purpose:** For the purchase of materials to achieve 4-H goals.
 - **MAXINE STONE MEMORIAL GRANT**
 - **Eligibility:** 4-H members in horticulture/agriculture project areas with demonstrated past achievement.
 - **Purpose:** For horticulture project area materials and projects.
